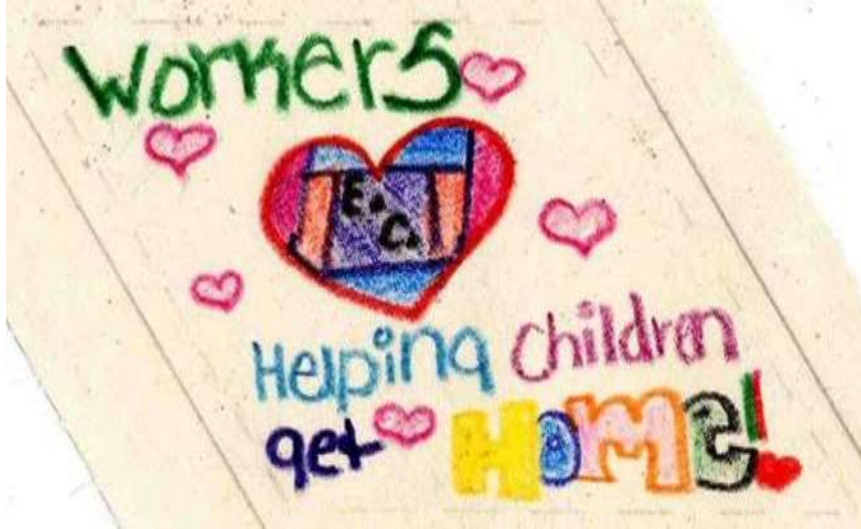


KW'S STORY
